

CHONC Workshop and Exam Requirements

Required Experience:

Please know that this course is not meant for individuals with limited billing or coding experience in hematology and oncology. AAPC recommends a minimum of 2 years of experience.

Deposit:

MSHO is pleased to be able to invest in our members by covering the cost of the instructor (\$3,500), study guide (\$79.95 each), exam (\$325 each), and proctor (\$500) for the CHONC workshop and exam. To reserve your spot, we require a check for \$179.95 as a deposit. Upon completion of the full course and exam, your uncashed check will be returned.
