#### [SB 136 Health Screenings](#) (Anthony)

**Summary:** Eliminates notification of dense breast tissue and provides for other general amendments to the use of radiation machines for mammography.

### **SB 475 Health Professionals (Wojno)**

**Summary:** Prohibits invasive bodily examinations under certain circumstances.

**Summary:** Adds definition of invasive bodily examination.

### **SB 462 Tobacco/Nicotine Licenses (Singh)**

**Summary:** Requires license to sell nicotine or tobacco products at retail.

### **SB 463 Criminal Penalties (Singh)**

**Summary:** Sunsets criminal penalties and civil sanctions for minors that purchase, possess, or use tobacco products, vapor products, or alternative nicotine products.

### **SB 464 Tobacco/Nicotine Licenses (Bellino)**

**Summary:** Allows tobacco or nicotine product licensee to sell nicotine or tobacco products at an unlicensed location under certain circumstances.

### **SB 465 Tobacco/Nicotine Licenses (Bellino)**

**Summary:** Creates certain temporary exemptions to the requirement that a person hold a license to sell a nicotine or tobacco product at retail.

### **SB 466 Tobacco (Cavanagh)**

**Summary:** Revises references to 1915 PA 31 in the age of majority act of 1971.

**Summary:** Requires reporting to secretary of state patients with conditions that that cause or contributes to a seizure under certain circumstances.
