House Bills

[HB 4006](#) Abortion ([Pohutsky](#))

Repeals penalty for administering with intent to procure miscarriage. Introduced (1/12/2023; To Judiciary Committee) Signed by the Governor (4/5/2023; Signed April 5, 2023; Effective date: 90 days after the sine die adjournment of the Legislature)

[HB 4071](#) Chemotherapy ([Steckloff](#))

Provides equal treatment for coverage for orally administered anticancer chemotherapy. Introduced (2/2/2023; To [Health Policy Committee](#)). Reported in Senate (10/4/2023; Substitute S-1 adopted; By [Health Policy Committee](#)). Presented in House (10/17/2023; Presented 10/17/2023)

[HB 4120](#) (PA 46) Child Protection ([Rogers](#))

Requires distribution of training package to individuals designated as mandatory reporters for child abuse or child neglect. Signed by the Governor (6/29/2023; Signed: June 29, 2023, Effective: September 26, 2023)

[HB 4362](#) (PA 100) Anatomical Gifts ([Brabec](#))

Provides opt-in option for individuals to participate in organ donor registry when filing taxes. Signed by the Governor (7/19/2023; Signed: July 19, 2023, Effective: July 19, 2023)

[HB 4363](#) (PA 101) Anatomical Gifts ([Neeley](#))

Allows inclusion on the donor registry of an individual who elects to be a donor on an income tax schedule. Signed by the Governor (7/19/2023; Signed: July 19, 2023, Effective: July 19, 2023)

[HB 4620](#) (PA 157) Health Insurers ([Edwards](#))

Prohibits denying coverage for preexisting conditions and prohibits canceling coverage based on health of insured. Signed by the Governor (10/19/2023; Signed: October 19, 2023, Effective: 90 days after sine die)

[HB 4621](#) (PA 158) Health Insurers ([Fitzgerald](#))

Requires coverage for dependents under the age of 26. Signed by the Governor (10/19/2023; Signed: October 19, 2023, Effective: 90 days after sine die)

[HB 4622](#) (PA 159) Health Insurers ([Miller](#))

Prohibits annual and lifetime dollar limits. Signed by the Governor (10/19/2023; Signed: October 19, 2023, Effective: 90 days after sine die)

[HB 4623](#) (PA 160) Health Insurers ([Koleszar](#))

Provides minimum required coverage. Signed by the Governor (10/19/2023; Signed: October 19, 2023, Effective: 90 days after sine die)

[SB 2](#) Abortion ([Geiss](#))

Repeals provision related to publication of cures for contraceptive preventatives. Introduced (1/12/2023; To [Health Policy Committee](#)) Signed by the Governor (4/5/2023; Signed: April 5, 2023; Effective: 90 days after the sine die adjournment of the Legislature)

SB 71 (PA 62) Medical Records ([Hauck](#))

Implements provision for the protection, retention, and maintenance of medical records referencing a vaginal or anal penetration treatment for 15 years by a health professional and health facility or agency and requires certain boards to provide guidance to licensees on medical services involving vaginal or anal penetration. Signed by the Governor (7/12/2023; Signed: July 11, 2023, Effective: October 9, 2023)

Repeals penalty for administering with intent to procure miscarriage. Introduced (1/24/2023; To [Health Policy Committee](#)). Received in House (3/8/2023; To [Judiciary Committee](#)). Passed in Senate (3/8/2023; 20-18; Earlier advanced to Third Reading)

SB 483 Pharmaceuticals ([Camilleri](#))

Creates prescription drug cost and affordability review act. Received in House (10/4/2023; To [Insurance and Financial Services Committee](#)). Passed in Senate (10/4/2023; 20-17)

SB 484 Health Insurers ([Klinefelt](#))

Requires compliance with the prescription drug cost and affordability review act. Received in House (10/4/2023; To [Insurance and Financial Services Committee](#)). Passed in Senate (10/4/2023; 20-17)

SB 485 Medical Services ([McDonald Rivet](#))

Requires compliance with the prescription drug cost and affordability review act. Received in House (10/4/2023; To [Insurance and Financial Services Committee](#)). Passed in Senate (10/4/2023; 20-17)

SB 44 Health Testing ([Wojno](#))

Prohibits invasive bodily examinations under certain circumstances. Introduced (1/26/2023; To [Health Policy Committee](#)). Committee Adopts Substitute/Amendment in Senate (10/18/2023; Substitute S-2 adopted; By [Health Policy Committee](#)). Reported in Senate (11/2/2023; Substitute S-2 adopted; By [Health Policy Committee](#)). Received in House (11/8/2023; To [Health Policy Committee](#)). Passed in Senate (11/8/2023; 35-0; Earlier advanced to Third Reading with committee substitute S-2 adopted.)

SB 45 Health Testing ([Santana](#))

Adds definition of invasive bodily examination. Introduced (1/26/2023; To [Health Policy Committee](#)). Committee Hearing in Senate [Health Policy Committee](#) (10/18/2023). Reported in Senate (11/2/2023; By [Health Policy Committee](#)). Received in House (11/8/2023; To [Health Policy Committee](#)). Passed in Senate (11/8/2023; 35-0; Earlier advanced to Third Reading.)
